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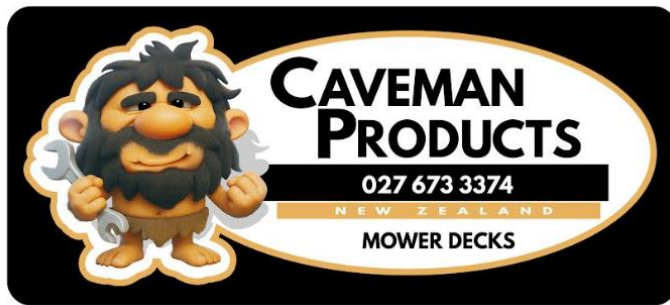

Gulf Harbour - Round 1

Welcome to round one of the NZ Offshore Powerboat Championships

Saturday 11th October 2025

You can view the race across from The Hammerhead Reserve, Tiri Road Reserve and Hobbs Point; Race Control will be on-water with off water located at The Hammerhead Reserve. This will also be the location of race-pits and can act as trailer parking once boats have been launched. Please be respectful of how you park and be mindful of pedestrians when travelling in a vehicle within the park.

Launching

Launching of boats will be at the Gulf Harbour Public Boat Ramp, please be mindful of the public as it is a public ramp. Be mindful to keep the ramp clear when not in use. Please if possible have a 3rd person to operate the tow vehicle to be as efficient as possible. We have available berthage in Gulf Harbour Marina so once scrutineered you may launch and raft inside one of our allocated berths. In order to do this PLEASE send a copy of your vessels insurance certificate to NZOPA. No Insurance, no marina entry.

On Retrieval, priority will be given to the larger vessels whilst the tide is full. From there please drop your trailer driver at the AT ferry berth to fetch your trailer. Then please wait outside the breakwater until you are marshalled into the ramp via VHF and call boat. Again it is a public ramp, please be courteous.

Please be organized, quick and give consideration to others at the ramp.

Meet and Greet – Saturday 4th October 2pm

Meet and greet will be held at 2Way Engineering, Patiki Road along with pre-season scrutineering for those who can make it. BBQ and Drinks at same time.

Prize Giving – 4pm Saturday 11th October

Prizegiving will be held at Mainsail Bar, with copious parking available on the grass out front. Mainsail is a short 1min car ride from the Boat Ramp. Mainsail also have a bistro for those looking for dinner afterwards and there is talk of a fantastic one-man band.

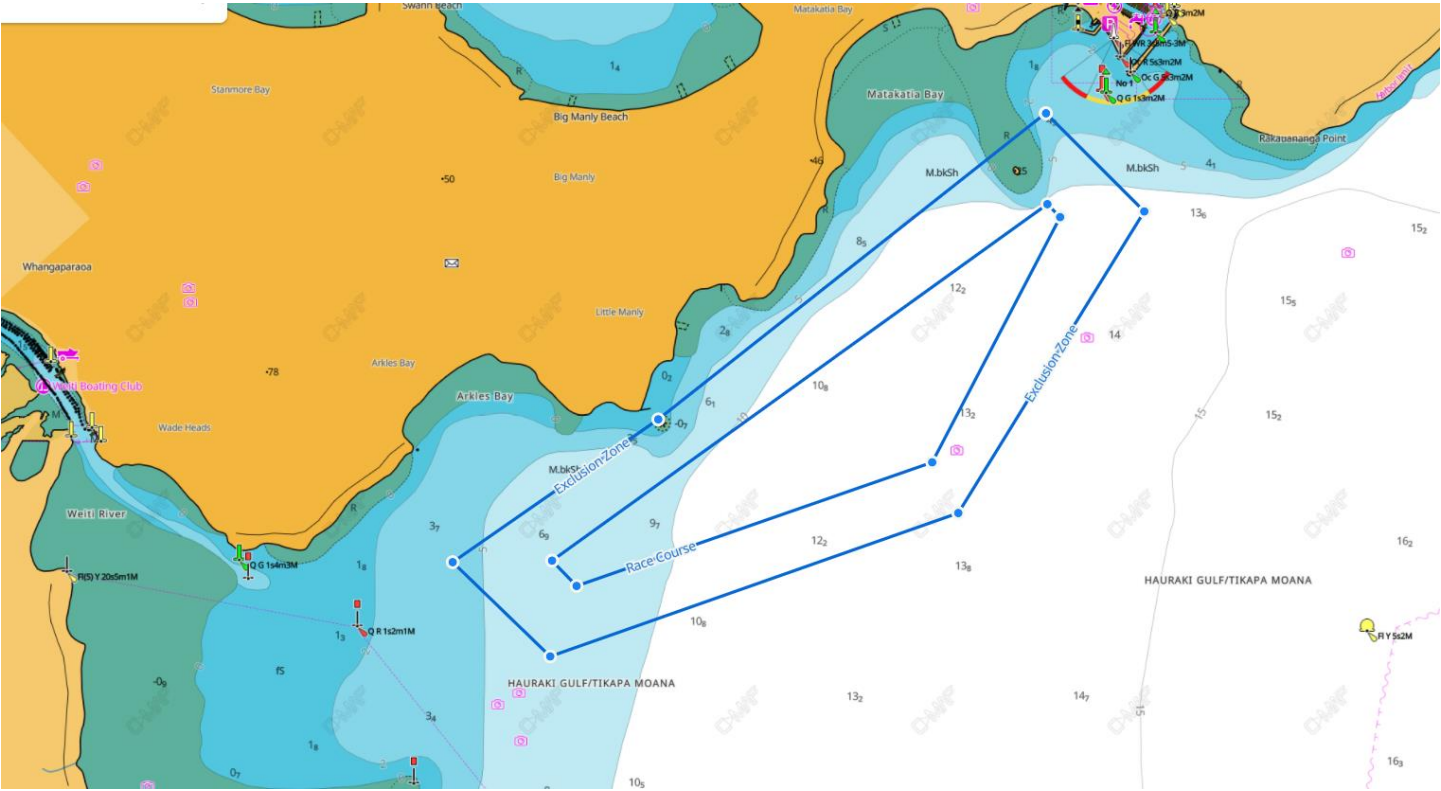
